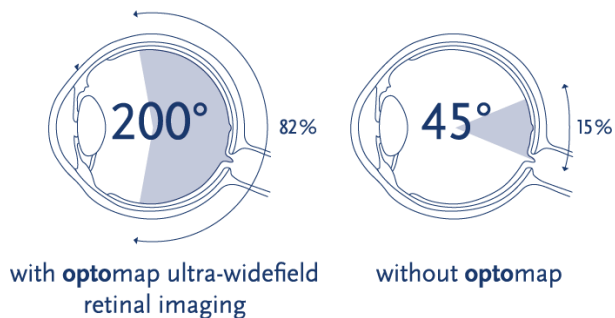


Advanced Digital Eye Examination

The Optomap Imaging is a 200 degree eye scan of your retina used to identify and monitor any eye disease. With an annual Optomap exams, we can better track your eye health for concerns, comparison, and treatments.



The doctor strongly recommends that **all patients** have this procedure performed annually. It is especially important for people who have:

- Headaches
- Flashes of Light
- Family History of: Glaucoma, Macular Degeneration, Retinal Disease, or Blindness
- Diabetes
- Floaters
- High Blood Pressure
- History of Retina Problems
- High Cholesterol

Our Advanced Digital Eye Exam with Optomap Imaging can help you safeguard both your eyesight and general health. There is a \$39 copay for the Advanced Digital Eye Exam which is not covered with insurance. *(Please advise staff if you have a history of epilepsy.)*

If you prefer to be dilated, then please allow an additional 45-60 minutes to your examination. Side effects of dilation can last to 4-6 hours and include: blurry vision and light sensitivity.

If you decline both the Advanced Digital Eye Exam and dilation, then please advise a staff. You understand that the potential for partial or total loss of vision may exist due to undetected eye disease and therefore release the doctors at Valley Optometry Eyecare Center from any liability resulting from failure to diagnose or treat any eye condition due to the lack of diagnostic information, which could have been obtained by performing this test.
